WHAT IS THE TEST?

New contract rules? His written test will be taken Separate from the Skills test. The written must be pas seed with an 80% or higher

The testing is comprised of written and skills based testing. The $\mathcal I$ written test is about a fifth of the test. Skills testing carries the most weight. The skills portion covers the types of things Painters do everyday on the job. Using Blueprint and Schedules, you will be asked to: Cut in, Brush and Roll Walls Using Multiple Colors of Latex; Apply Alkyd Materials by Brushing, Rolling, Conventional and Airless Spray; and Apply Clear Finishes to Wood. All Paints, Masking Materials and Spray Equipment will be provided. A Wide Range of Roller Covers and Brushes will be available.

Painters Should Wear Whites And Work Boots. Bring your Grip, Respirator Fit Card, and Respirator.

Bringing your own supplies is allowed + encouraged
